Guiding document for all town plans for at least the next 10 years

Data driven snapshot of where we are now and what has changed since the last plan

Lays out a Vision Statement, Goals, Objectives, and concrete, realistic actions the Town can take to achieve that vision

Provides an implementation strategy for actions

# Why is a Master Plan important for Boylston?

Ensures consistency in planning


Promotes continuity of vision

Provides a baseline for town decision making

Gives the Town a leg up with certain grant opportunities

Establishes a guiding set of principles that inform other plans and actions for the next decade




### Population Growth


#### Household Growth 2000 - 2019



#### Household Growth, Boylston and Surrounding Communities, 2000 - 2019



#### Median Age 2000 Compared to 2019




#### Median Age, 2000-2019


#### **Boylston Housing Unit Building Permits by Year, 2006-2019**

**Boylston Single-Family Home Median Sale Price and Total Sales by Year** 






Household Income by Level of Income, 2019





## Survey Outreach


- Ran from January 25<sup>th</sup> to March 15<sup>th</sup>
- Collected 433 responses from Boylston residents
- 95% of respondents are current resident homeowners
- 36% over age 60
- 29% under age 45


#### What is your age group? Select one.


