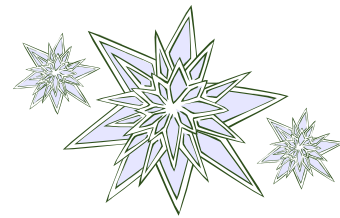

Pre-registration is required for all our programs and events (Unless otherwise noted) If the office is closed, Registration forms may be dropped off in the Town Offices drop off box located outside the front door of the Municipal office building.

All registrations are first come, first served basis. Registration forms are required for every individual participating in our programming. Registration forms are available in this brochure, online, or you may contact us. Payment must accompany the completed registration form. All checks are made payable to Boylston Parks & Recreation. Waivers on registration forms must be signed, otherwise participation in the program will not be allowed. Incomplete registration forms are subject to being returned to the sender. We cannot be held responsible for lost or misdirected mail.

****If you Wait - You may be too late****

Nothing jeopardizes a recreation program faster than waiting until the last minute to register. All programs require a high level of coordination, including facility scheduling, staffing, advertising, and purchasing of supplies. Register no later than 10 days before a program begins and save \$\$\$. Those who sign up "late" (less than 10 days of the program start date) will need to pay a higher rate in order to help offset the additional administrative costs that arise due to the late registration.

Non-Residents are Welcome to join any program at no additional fee!!

Code of Conduct

Equal Access: No participants shall, on the basis of race, sex, creed, national origin or disability be denied access to programs, activities, services or benefits.

In order to ensure the quality and enjoyment of parks and recreation programs and to promote a safe and positive atmosphere for the programs, All participants, staff, parents and persons involved with the programs (i.e. spectators, coaches, volunteers, etc.) shall abide by the following code of conduct:

- All persons shall act with respect towards other persons, their privacy and safety.
- Physical or verbal abuse of any kind will not be tolerated.
- All persons shall act with respect toward public and private property and equipment
- Program rules and regulations shall be observed at all times.

Any Town representative responsible for officiating, supervising or otherwise operating a parks & recreation program shall have authority to enforce the terms of this Code, as authorized by the Boylston Parks & Recreation board.

Our Fields and Gym are available for Rent? Do you belong to a sports team/Group and are looking for field space? Planning a family reunion and need a large area with plenty of parking? Looking for a gym to have a basketball game, indoor practice? Contact BPR for an application & fee Schedule, or Log onto to our website at www.boylston-ma.gov/parks and download an application. All requests must attend a meeting for approval.

You can take several self guided family hikes in Central Massachusetts? Pick up a "Self-Guided Family Hikes" brochure in the Parks & Recreation office for directions on several hikes. The brochure outlines the difficulty as well as the length of the hike. Explore Parks and State Forests in Central Massachusetts!

You can Borrow a DCR Park Pass? The Recreation office has a Park Pass to Loan out. Use at most all Massachusetts State Parks and pay nothing to park! Contact the Office to borrow the pass.

You can go Letterboxing in Boylston? What is Letterboxing? It's an intriguing pastime combining navigational skills & rubber stamp artistry in a charming "Treasure Hunt" style outdoor quest. Stop by the Recreation office and pick up your Letterboxing booklet today!

Boylston Recycles? Stop by the Municipal Office Building, bring your junk mail, magazines, old phone books, newspapers and more and simply drop in the Big Green & Yellow dumpster located just outside the front door.

Why Parks are important? Parks are free & accessible to everyone. Parks help us breathe. They are filled with trees which give us oxygen, and are home to many wild animals and birds. In fact, if it weren't for National Parks, some endangered species might not even survive! Just think how life would be without parks...

Hillside has miles of trails? The Hillside Complex has miles of trails that wind through the property, crossing through fields. It offers recreational opportunities to multiple users. Hikers, Cross-Country skiers, bikers, hunters, horse back riders and bird watches. As you walk through trails there are many reminders of the past history of Hillside as a working farm. Stonewalls crisscross the property, old foundations from buildings and apple trees growing in the under story of the forest. Enjoy yourself with your travels on the trails!

For your enjoyment, Parks & Recreation offers the following Facilities:

In the Center of Town, residents can enjoy tennis courts, a basketball court & swings. In the winter, Ice Skating is enjoyed by all ages.

At our Hillside complex, Home of Boylston Youth Soccer, we offer a 200+ acre parcel that is also home of the Municipal Offices & Police Department. Also you will find a covered pavilion picnic area, & a playground. Located in the Municipal Office Building we have an indoor gym that is available for rent for a variety of uses. In the Morningdale section of town, just off Route 70 you will find the Manor Park, home of Boylston Youth Baseball. Tennis courts, basketball courts and a playground with swings can be enjoyed by all.

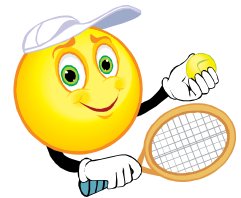

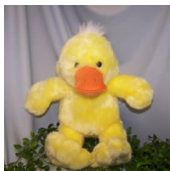

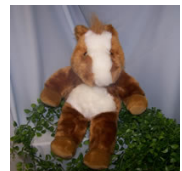
