AGENT'S REPORT

<u>Tahanto Septic Tank Update</u> – The tank is working as it should be. It was pumped, pressure washed and inspected. There were no cracks, but they did find that one of the ribs was discolored and bulging. This could have possibly happened during the vacuum test. Every seam in the tank was cleaned and grouted. It was filled on Thursday and checked on Friday. It is holding the level it should. It will be checked again in another month.

Dennis told the architect that he wants a forensic as-built plan from the school to the leach field. One was never done. An installer's as-built was received, but never one from the design engineer. The inverts in the driveway could be wrong, but it is only speculation until the as-built is received. The architect will contact the engineering firm.

Dennis received a report from the EOC drill last month. Region 2 did well in responding. The report received today shows it as being closed, but the report Dennis has says the items were delivered. He will check on it.

A vaccine reimbursement check was received from UMass in the amount of \$421.70. It will be deposited into the revolving fund.

Reports from Mosquito Control were received.
