REGULAR MEETING MINUTES

JANUARY 27, 2014

Jim and Shawn Goulet (383 Sewall Street) attended to discuss tree cutting to be sure they were in compliance with the commission. They are in the process of installing hay bales and silt fencing for Nature's View and will begin work after recording the documents issued by both the Conservation and the Planning Boards. Shawn Goulet asked specifically about lot 5. The Order of Conditions that was issued to Nature's View states that prior to construction a filing is required for lots 4 & 5. It was suggested they file for both lots at the same time.

Jimmy Ricciardi (183 Main Street) was in attendance. He is having the wetlands delineated and would like the commission to visit the site. He proposes to replace the existing system and remove trees and brush from the area but is not sure if he is in the buffer zone. Joe McGrath said if he gives us his wetlands scientist's information, it can be passed along to Paul McManus (EcoTec) and they can coordinate a time. Joe also told him that the applicant typically reimburses the commission for the cost, but will defer this until he files.

Vouchers were approved.
