Board of Assessors Minutes

- Meeting brought to order at 6:03 PM. In attendance were Rebecca Dono Healy, Tom Martiska,
 David Manzello, and Jack Valleli, with Van Baker attending via Zoom.
- Rebecca moved to approve the October meeting minutes with a change to the wording of line item #5. Tom seconded. The vote was 3-0 in favor.
- 3. The importance of a reliable base of data in assessment cannot be overstated. The Board is pleased to hear that we are in a better position to understand changes occurring demographically with regard to assessment and sales.
- 4. While paper records are less important nowadays, it's important that we have accessible records for the inevitable records requests.
- 5. The settlement in the case of Skritakis v. Boylston (65 Perry) reflects only a change in construction completion percentage as of July 1, 2022. It is not a substantive change in the finished value of the property. This is an acceptable compromise, the Board agreed.
- 6. The preliminary tax rate of \$13.81/thousand has been approved by the State, and proceeded to the Selectmen, also on November 6, and there it was also approved.
- 7. The Board is pleased to hear that so much of the year-end work has proceeded smoothly.
- 8. Rebecca moved to approve qualifying exemption applications as a batch. Tom seconded, with Van abstaining. Nine Chapter 22, three Chapter 41Cs, and 2 CPA exemptions were thus approved 2-0-1.
- 9. Tom moved to adjourn at 6:39 PM. Rebecca seconded. The vote was unanimous in favor.
